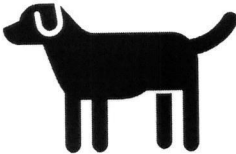

Have you noticed any behavior changes in your older pet recently? They could be signs of a medical, or behavior issue or, possibly, dementia. To help narrow the cause, please check all that apply.

Disorientation-awareness-spatial orientation

- ☐ Pacing during the day
- ☐ Seems confused or disoriented
- ☐ Stares blankly at wall, the floor or into space
- ☐ Hass been meowing or whimpering for no apparent reason
- ☐ Drops food and has a problem finding it
- ☐ Goes to the hinge or wrong side of door
- ☐ Has not been recognizing familiar people or familiar pets
- ☐ Experienced any seizures

Altered social interactions

- ☐ Showing increased attention seeking or over attachment to family members
- ☐ Interacts less with the family or other pets

Sleep-wake cycles

- ☐ Is experiencing instances of waking or being restless at night
- ☐ Is sleeping noticeably more during the day
- ☐ Sleeps almost around the clock

Housetraining, learning and memory

- ☐ Has been soiling indoors: Urine stools
- ☐ Is showing a decreased response to its name or learned command, tricks or work

Body Functions

- ☐ Has difficulty chewing
- ☐ Has gained/ lost weight (circle one)
- ☐ Change in how much they eat
- ☐ Is drinking more water than usual
- ☐ Is urinating more frequently
- ☐ Leaks urine when asleep
- ☐ Leaks urine when awake
- ☐ Vomits more than occasionally
- ☐ Having trouble seeing or hearing (circle one or both)

Anxiety or response to stimuli

- ☐ More fearful, anxious, or unsettled
- ☐ Increased anxiety when separated from family
- ☐ Increased fear in new places

Activity

- ☐ Reduced physical activity: walking, running, swimming, or playing
- ☐ Needs help walking, rising, etc.
- ☐ Shows signs of pain: Hiding, limping, panting, unusually quiet, or vocalizing (circle all that apply)

Skin and Coat

- ☐ Nails longer than normal
- ☐ Not grooming well
- ☐ Scratches, licks, and chews excessively
- ☐ Changes in haircoat, skin, or new lumps or bumps: Flaky, dry, oily, unkempt (circle all that apply)
