



## INTERNATIONAL PET TRAVEL

When traveling with your pet(s), there are specific animal health requirements for each country that your pet will need to meet. As soon as you know your travel details, please contact our office. Please note, that preparing for travel to some countries will take time. To obtain a health certificate some vaccinations, diagnostic testing, or administration of medications/ treatments may also be required for some destinations.

### WE WILL NEED AT LEAST 10 DAYS NOTICE TO PREPARE THE APPROPRIATE PAPERWORK YOU WILL NEED

**Here is what you will need to have prepared in order to schedule an appointment.**

- 1 - Exact date the pet is leaving the U.S. \_\_\_\_\_ Exact date arriving in the destination country \_\_\_\_\_
- 2 - Is the patient active in our system & have we seen the pet before? \_\_\_\_\_
- 3- Record of all vaccinations given, and flea and tick prevention? \_\_\_\_\_
