AUTHORIZATION FOR MEDICAL, DENTAL AND/OR SURGICAL TREATMENT

I am the owner of/or am responsible for this animal and have the authority to execute this consent. I have the authority to authorize the administration of medications, tests, anesthetics, and/or surgical procedures.

As a prerequisite to my animal being admitted, all vaccinations must be current and my animal must be free of internal/external parasites (fleas, ticks, worms, etc). If any of these issues are present at admission, I authorize any vaccinations or treatments needed to correct these issues. I understand that appropriate charges will be added to my bill.

Pre-Anesthetic Blood Work

For the protection of your pet, we HIGHLY recommend a pre-anesthetic blood panel be performed. This will insure that your pet is in the low risk category during anesthesia by ruling out pre-existing internal problems that may not be physically evident.

The cost of pre-anesthetic blood work: Junior Wellness (<7yrs old) is \$100.00 Senior Wellness (>7yrs old) is \$125.00 Blood work: YES NO

Fluid Therapy/IV Catheter: Recommended if <7 yrs old, REQUIRED if > 7 yrs old

Having an IV catheter placed in your pet before anesthesia offers a direct route to the bloodstream. Administering fluids can help reduce the stress on the heart, assist in maintaining your pet's temperature and hydration, and reduce the time it takes for your pet to fully recover from the anesthesia.

IV catheter for dogs and cats: \$50.00 Fluid therapy: YES NO

Heartworm testing (dogs) OR Feline Leukemia/FIV/Heartworm (cats)

It is recommended that your dog be given a yearly heartworm test.

It is recommended that your cat be checked for Feline Leukemia/FIV if never before tested or if outside. Combo Test Cost? \$44.00

Microchip Implanting (Home Again®)

We recommend that all pets be implanted with a microchip for identification. The cost (includes 1st year registration) is \$46.50.
