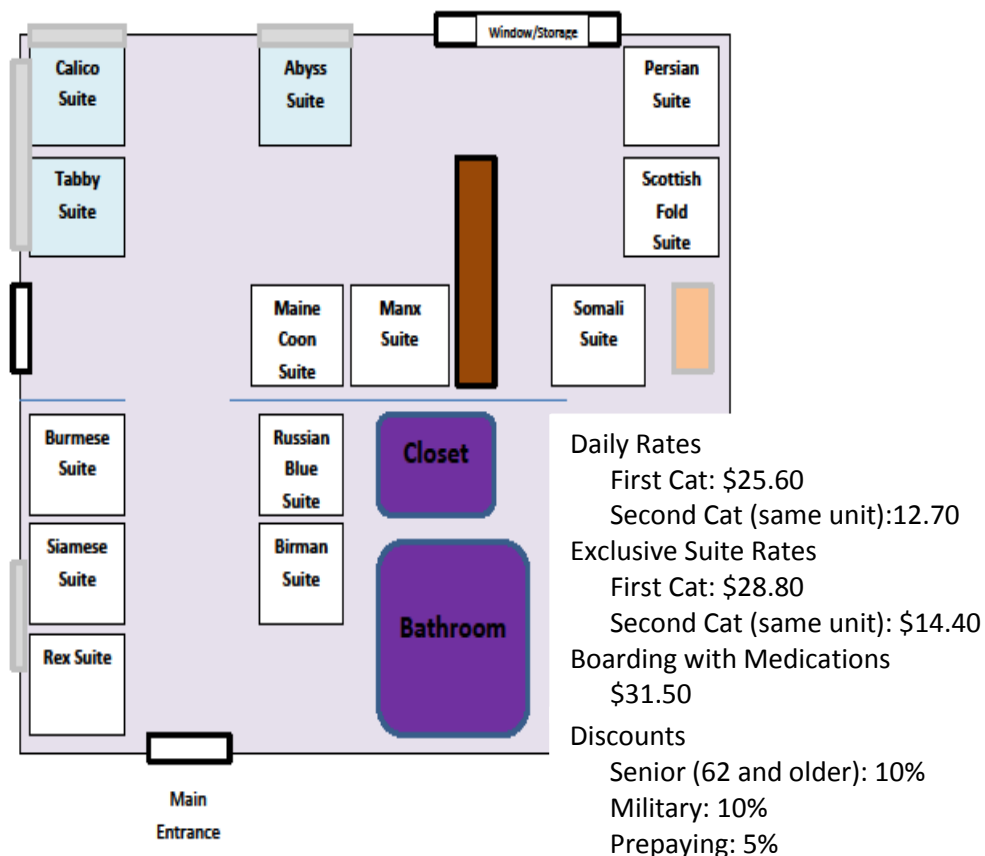

Before We Board Your Feline

Please Plan Ahead:

Our doctors want to do a brief exam with you and your feline so we can ensure the best care.

Current Rabies and FVRCP vaccines are required.

Flea control is required. Your feline must have been treated for fleas within the last 30 days. If you have not recently treated for fleas, make sure your feline is treated 24 hours before check-in.

Please allow yourself time to fill out paperwork for your feline.
