Boarding Agreement

Vaccination Policy: All pets must have proof of required immunizations by a licensed veterinarian & be parasite free prior to boarding.

DOGS: DA2PPC & Rabies within the last 12 months (2-3yr vaccines accepted)

Bordetella within the last 12 months

CATS: FVRCP & Rabies within the last 12 months (2-3yr vaccines)

If it cannot be documented that your pet is current on vaccinations, you authorize the administration of the required vaccines here at your expense. If your pet is found to have parasites such as fleas, ticks or intestinal parasites they will be treated at your expense.

Personal Items: We recommend leaving only your pet's food & medications. To maintain our high standard for safety & sanitation, we will provide all bowls & bedding. We cannot be held responsible for any lost, damaged, or destroyed items. Medication will be administered as prescribed, an administrative fee of \$1 per day additional will be assessed. (Pets with more than 5 medications or diabetes will be assessed \$5 per day)

Gastrointestinal Upset: Being away from home, experiencing new sights, smells, & sounds, eating different food, or even just being excited can affect your pet's gastrointestinal homeostasis. Diarrhea & weight loss can be common after effects & stool should return to normal after a few days of your pet being back at home & experiencing their normal routine. *This is why we strongly recommend bringing food from home for your pet.*

Check In/Out: Check in time is any time during lobby hours (M-F 8-6 & Sat 8-12) the day of arrival. During major holidays/peak times we ask that you drop your pet off as late in the day as possible to allow staff time to clean and sanitize kennels. Check out time is by 3pm on the departure date. Please let staff know if you need to make arrangements for late pick-ups and we will work with you the best we can (space permitting)

Payment for the services provided are due in full at the time your pet is released from Spring Hill Veterinary Clinic with NO EXCEPTIONS.

Medical Illness Policy: The advantage of boarding your pet(s) at a veterinary hospital is that veterinary attention is readily available should the need arise. This facility cannot guarantee the health of any animal, but pledges to provide appropriate care to all boarders. In case of emergency, we will call you then the emergency contact listed regarding your pet's condition, treatment options, & estimated additional costs. If no one can be reached, please indicate your wishes below by initialing.

___Please perform whatever services the veterinarian deems necessary for the best care of my pet until someone can be reached. This includes only non-elective treatments & necessary diagnostics.

___Do not administer any medical treatment until specific authorization is given. I understand that this _____ could result in life threatening conditions to go untreated or prolonged pain and suffering for my pet.

*I agree to hold this facility harmless for conditions that often are unavoidable in boarding environments including, but not limited to; weight loss or gain, kennel cough, upper respiratory infection, diarrhea.

To ensure the protection of my pet & all pets under the care of the Spring Hill Veterinary Clinic; I have read, understand & agree to all aforementioned boarding policies.
