Older cats can develop a myriad of medical problems, but there are three common problems that we see in the geriatric patient-----diabetes, kidney disease, and hyperthyroidism. All three diseases affect the other systems over time and are, if left untreated at an early stage, fatal. Of these chronic disease processes are detected soon after they start, they may be very treatable and controllable. Generally, we recommend that cats seven years and older have blood drawn and checked annually. Diagnostic tests include blood chemistries, a complete blood count, and thyroid test. It is in this way, we can detect the problem before it becomes a major medical problem. As in all health evaluations, early detection is the key as it allows for more and better treatment options. The cost for these procedures is \$129.50 and is highly recommended.

We have tried to make our senior care program as affordable as possible, so that your pets' may benefit from the same test and evaluations that we use on our own aging pets. We know how difficult it is to say goodbye to an old friend, therefore we hope to keep you and your pet together as many years as possible. Thank you for entrusting us with your pet's health.
