

## Vaccine Protocol

Age	Dog	Cat
6-8 weeks	Dhpp	FVRCP
9-11 weeks	Dhpp, Bo	FVRCP, FeLV
12-14 weeks	Dhpp, Bo, RV	FVRCP, FeLV, RV
15-17 weeks	Dhpp (highly recommended)	

\* If you have a black and tan breed (rottweiler, doberman) you will need the 4th Dhpp\*

1 year	Dhpp, Bo, RV	FVRCP, FeLV, RV
2 year	Dhpp, Bo	FVRCP, FeLV
3 year	Dhpp, Bo	FVRCP, FeLV
4 year	Dhpp, Bo, RV	FVRCP, FeLV, RV

\* The bordatella vaccine needs to be given before your animal is placed in a boarding facility. Boarding facilities like to have the vaccine done every 6 months, although the vaccine is good for 1 year\*

\* Your pet's body takes about 2 weeks to build an immunity to the virus in the vaccines. This means your pet is not fully protected until about 2 weeks after the vaccine is given.\*

\*Dhpp- Distemper/Parvo

\* Bo- Bordatella (Kennel cough)

\*RV- Rabies

\*FVRCP (Feline upper respiratory)

\* FeLV (Feline leukemia)
