

**EMERGENCY SERVICES**

Here at Animal Medical Center, we emphasize preventive medicine. However, we understand that unforeseen emergencies can and do occur. Rest assured that we offer complete emergency services here at our hospital during normal business hours.

Our comprehensive in-house laboratory and digital radiology system enable us to obtain rapid diagnostic information specific to your animal's needs. Some of our rapid service includes complete blood count (CBC), chemistry profile, electrolytes, blood glucose and urine analysis. Our state-of-the-art digital radiology system (X-ray) lets us view the images within seconds of taking the X-ray and enables consultations with board-certified radiologists.

Along with our in-house diagnostics, we also provide advanced veterinary care and monitoring on site. This includes oxygen therapy, IV fluid therapy, pulse oximetry, electrocardiography, Doppler blood pressure, pain management, body warming therapy, orthopedic and soft tissue care, and trauma care.
