BOARDING POLICIES

- ALL Boarding pets must be up to date on the required vaccinations, which are:
CANINE - Rabies, Bordetella, Distemper and Parvo
FELINE - Rabies and FVRCP
If your pet is not up to date on these necessary vaccinations or you can not provide proof of vaccination, they WILL BE GIVEN and the FEES WILL BE ADDED TO YOUR INVOICE.
- Any pet that becomes ill with vomiting or diarrhea due to the stress of boarding WILL BE TREATED and the FEES WILL BE ADDED TO YOUR INVOICE.
If a more serious condition arises, all attempts will be made to contact the owner or responsible emergency contact to discuss treatment options. If no responsible party is available, the doctors and staff will act in the best interest of the pet and the FEES WILL BE ADDED TO YOUR INVOICE.
- Boarding dogs are walked at least two times daily in a safe, fenced in backyard. Boarding cats have their litter pans changed at least twice daily and are kept in a separate room from the dogs. All pets reside in clean, comfortable, individual cages that are monitored throughout the day. All facilities are heated and air-conditioned.
- Any pet that becomes soiled while boarding due to urination, diarrhea, etc. will be bathed at an additional cost to the owner unless prior instructions are given.

HURRICANE POLICY

In the event of an evacuation due to an approaching hurricane, Lake Animal Hospital will not be able to board any animals. We cannot ensure the safety and/or adequate care under these circumstances. If you are boarding your pet during hurricane season, we require that you have made prior arrangements for the evacuation of your pets. We require two contacts with phone numbers of responsible parties. At least one contact must be local.
Please know that the well being of your pet is our only concern. Many animals perished when left behind during Hurricane Katrina and we are doing our best to prevent a recurrence of that tragedy.

SUMMATION OF AUTHORIZATION

- 1 In the event that a hurricane evacuation is called and a responsible party does not evacuate my pet; I do not hold Lake Animal Hospital liable or responsible for his/her safety.
- 2 I authorize the medical care and treatment of my pet should he/she become ill while boarding and understand that accumulated charges for such services will be applied to my invoice.
- 3 As owner or authorized agent of this pet(s), I authorize the above-described services and understand that I am responsible for full payment of services at the time of discharge.
