When Does Class Meet?

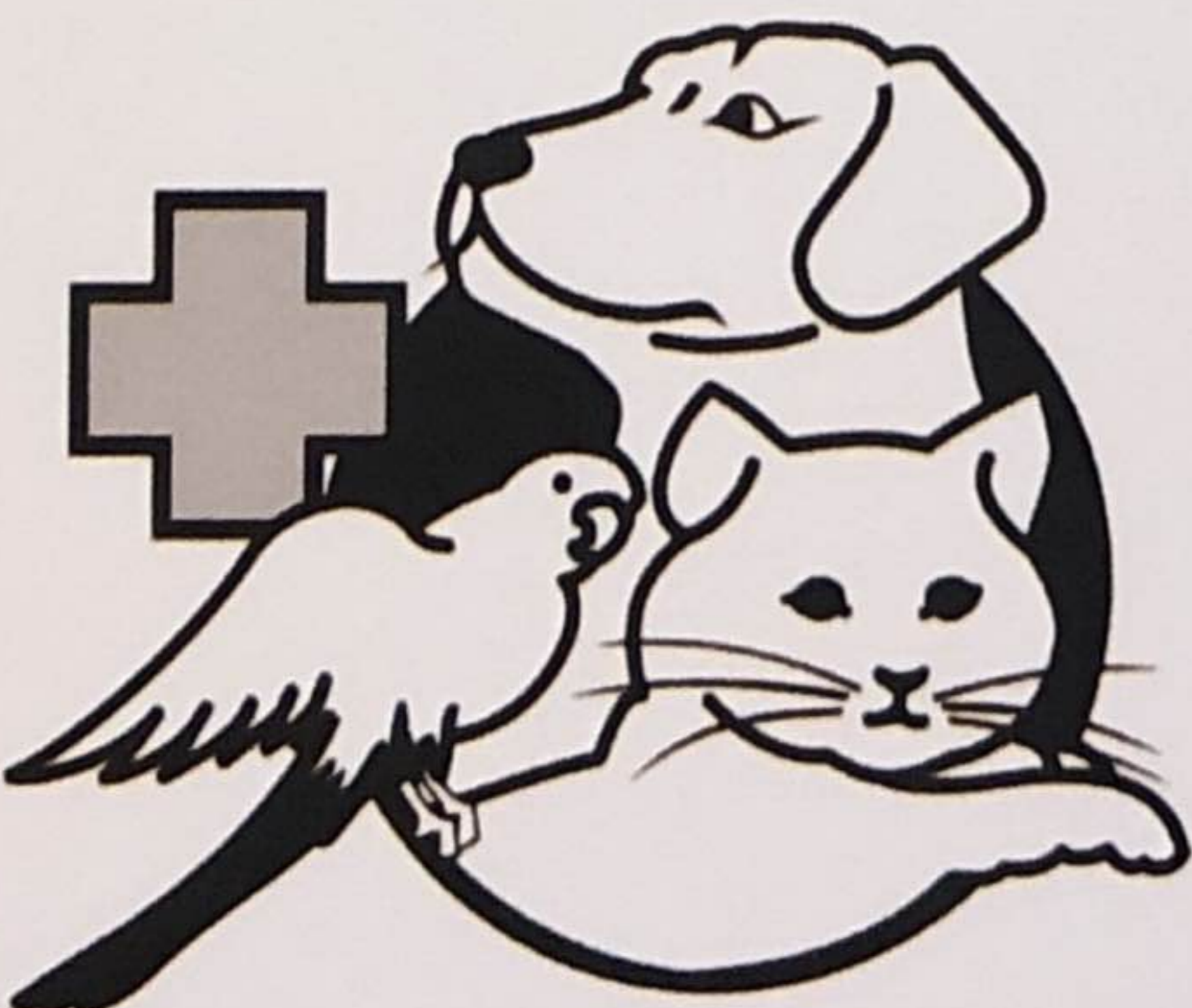
